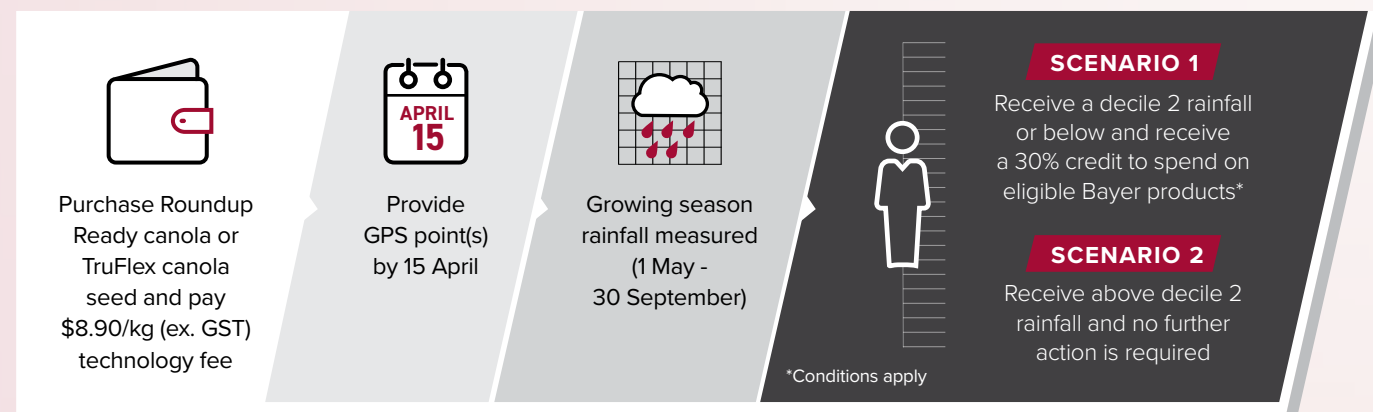
IS A SIMPLE WAY TO HELP MANAGE THE RISK OF LOW GROWING SEASON RAINFALL

The DecilePro® Program is a simple way to help you manage low growing season rainfall. In 2020, all TruFlex canola and Roundup Ready canola technology fees are now eligible for Bayer's DecilePro program*, which helps farmers to manage low growing season rainfall.

KEY INFORMATION:

- All trait purchases of TruFlex® canola or Roundup Ready® canola in 2020 are now eligible for DecilePro*.
- Only pay one simple technology fee - \$8.90 (ex. GST) per kilogram.
- Purchase and provide your specific field(s) GPS point(s) to your Technology Service Provider by 15 April 2020.
- Growing season rainfall will be measured between 1 May and 30 September 2020.
- Receive a decile 2 or below rainfall and receive a **30% credit** to be used for eligible Bayer products*.

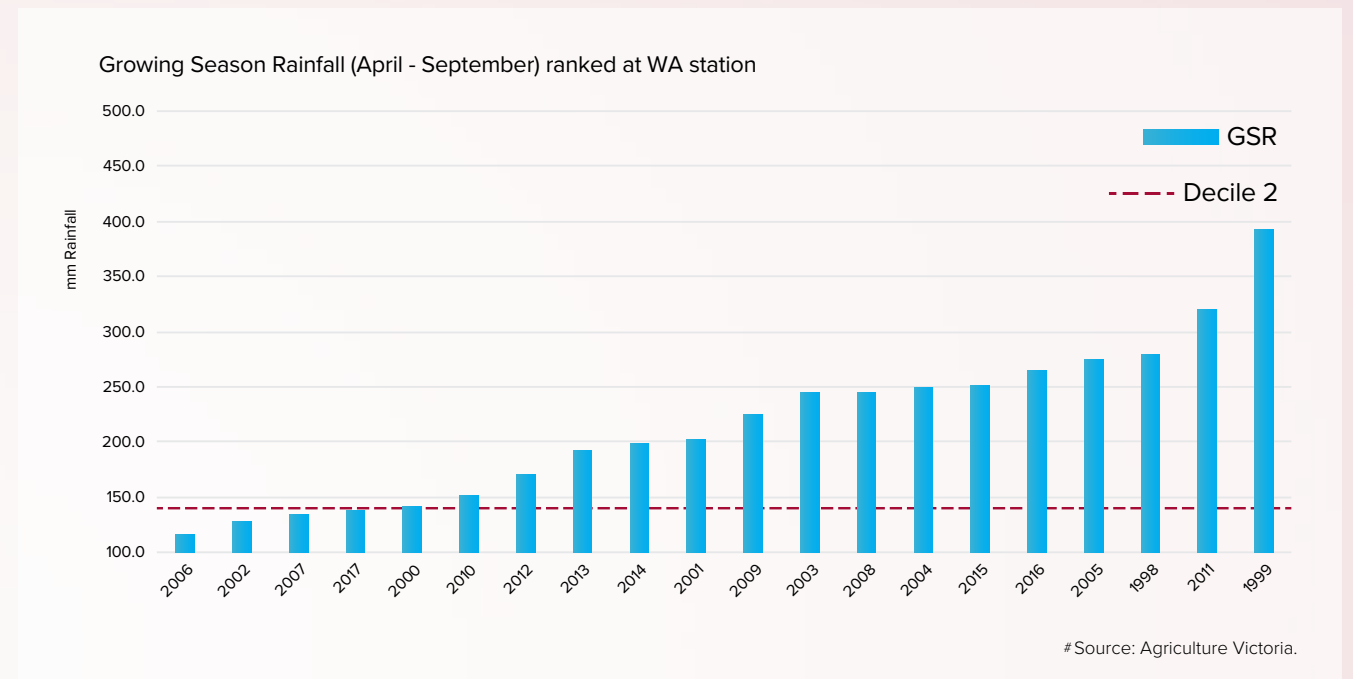

WHAT IS A RAINFALL DECILE?

Rainfall deciles are calculated by taking the observed rainfall record at a location and sorting the rainfall amounts into ten equal parts. Decile 1 would be the years with the lowest rainfall on record and decile 10 would be the years with the highest rainfall on record#.

DecilePro is specific to each farm. By providing GPS point(s), unique rainfall amounts are used, based on each grid's deciles. This means every farm has a different decile 2. See the example from WA.

WHERE CAN I BUY ROUNDUP READY CANOLA SEED?

HOW DO I REGISTER TO GROW ROUNDUP READY TECHNOLOGIES?

Growers wishing to grow Roundup Ready Technologies need to sign a License and Stewardship Agreement (LSA) and complete an accreditation. This does not cost anything and there is also no obligation to plant a crop once you've signed the agreement.

The LSA provides you with the right to purchase and plant TruFlex and Roundup Ready canola seed in accordance with the license terms and conditions, including the Crop Management Plan (CMP), and all other regulatory requirements. Growers must sign a LSA and be accredited prior to taking delivery of TruFlex and Roundup Ready canola seed.

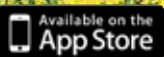
